Norwegian celebrates Halloween with flash sale including flights to the US from just £129.99 one-way

Over 2,000 long-haul seats on sale and flights to Europe from £27 one-way

Norwegian is getting into the Halloween spirit by offering holidaymakers the chance to bag a bargain flight to their favourite holiday destination this winter. The sale will include savings on over 2,000 seats to the US starting from just £129.99 one-way and flights to Europe available from just £26.99 one way.

The Halloween flash sale will last for three days only (31st October to 2nd November 22.59) and flights can be booked on www.norwegian.com/uk/flight-deals-halloween-uk using code **HALLOWEENUK17**. The flash sale covers select routes from London Gatwick on travel between 13th November 2017 to 18th March 2018 including:

London Gatwick direct to the USA from £129.99 one-way for a spook-tacular trip

- **Boston** – in the heart of Massachusetts, Boston is the ideally gateway for a haunted holiday. Just 30 minutes away from the mysterious Salem – well known for its witch trials. *Fly direct to Boston for just £129.90 one way.*
- **Seattle** – Head to Kells Irish Restaurant and Pub to experience the spooky side of Seattle, named the most haunted bar in the world by some. *Flights available from £159.90 one way.*
- **Denver** – just over an hour outside of Denver, situated in Estes Park is The Stanley Hotel – the inspiration of Stephen King's The

Shining. *For a haunted stay fly to Denver direct from London Gatwick from £159.90 one way.*

- **Orlando** – While not the obvious choice for a scare, Orlando is home to a number of haunted establishments including Princeton Hospital and the ultra-scary Super 8 International Drive. *Flights available from £169.90 one way.*

- **Alicante** – more than just a winter sun destination, travellers to Alicante can experience a real-life haunted house escape game, Xcapate. *Fly direct from £27*
- **Fuerteventura** – in 1994 SS America shipwrecked on the beach of Garcey on the west coast of Fuerteventura. Still viable until 2013, now virtually nothing is left standing – providing a rather eerie sight. *Flights start from £31 one way.*
- **Salzburg** – other than fantastic skiing, Austria is home to one of the most haunted places in Europe. Moosham Caste has become known as the ‘Witches Castle’ over the centuries and is said to be still haunted today. *Fares start from £27 one way.*

Norwegian Chief Commercial Officer Thomas Ramdahl said: “Our 3-day Halloween flash sale will give passengers a spook-tacular treat on fares to the US and Europe.
