# Norwegian launches domestic flights in Argentina

- Travelling onward from Buenos Aires to discover the beauty of Argentina is now easier and better value than ever before thanks to Norwegian
- The new routes will connect Buenos Aires with Córdoba, Mendoza, Iguazú, Bariloche, Neuquén and Salta
- Flights on selected routes commence from 16<sup>th</sup> October 2018

Norwegian is proud to announce the launch of six domestic routes in Argentina allowing passengers to fly affordably from Buenos Aires across the country. Flights are available to book now from Buenos Aires to Córdoba, Mendoza, Iguazú, Bariloche, Neuquén and Salta with prices from just £49.70 one-way.

Initially commencing on the 16<sup>th</sup> October 2018 with two routes to Cordoba and Mendoza, with services to Iguazu and Neuquen starting on 19<sup>th</sup> November and Bariloche and Salta beginning on 3<sup>rd</sup> December.

Passengers travelling on Norwegian's route from London Gatwick to Buenos Aires Ezeiza International Airport can take advantage of the new flights departing from the city's domestic airport which is a short taxi or bus transfer away.

The airline's domestic routes in Argentina will be operated by a modern and efficient fleet of Boeing 737-800 aircraft. Passengers will experience the same level of award-winning service and comfort as Norwegian's European short haul operation.

Domestic flights to six cities across Argentina are available to book now, as there is a change of airport required tickets must be purchased separately from the London Gatwick to Buenos Aires flight. Passengers can easily take the opportunity to split their journey and spend time visiting the vibrant city of Buenos Aires before exploring other parts of Argentina.

#### Buenos Aires to Cordoba is now available to book from £49.70 one way:

Situated in the geographic centre of Argentina, Cordoba is the second largest

city in the country and is renowned for its incredible selection of colonial Spanish architecture and including a World Heritage UNESCO site.

#### Buenos Aires to Mendoza is now available to book from £63.80 one way:

Located in the central northern part of the country Mendoza is Argentina's most important wine region with vineyards planted at some of the highest altitudes in the world. Mendoza is also a popular starting point for climbers wishing to scale the Aconcagua mountain and adventure travellers keen on horse riding, hiking and mountaineering.
