Norwegian launches UK's cheapest direct flights to Chicago from £140

- Airline to commence daily service from London to Chicago from £140 (£265 return)
- Global expansion continues with airline's first route to the US Midwest

Norwegian, voted 'World's Best Low Cost Long Haul Airline', will commence the UK's cheapest direct flights to Chicago this weekend from £139.90 one way available to book now at <u>www.norwegian.com/uk</u>

From 25 March, Norwegian will commence a daily nonstop service from London Gatwick Airport to Chicago O'Hare International Airport – the airline's first and only route to Chicago on its global network.

Passengers will fly in comfort on brand new Boeing 787 Dreamliner aircraft offering up to 344 leather seats in modern economy and Premium cabins. The year-round service is Norwegian's first new route from London to the USA in 2018 as the airline continues its long-haul expansion from the UK.

Europe's third largest low-cost airline, will operate its newly delivered 787 Dreamliners on the Chicago route that feature a new expanded 56-seat Premium cabin which offers passengers more than a metre of legroom with enhanced service. These new aircraft have been in operation since February and are part of Norwegian's commitment to operate its newest aircraft from the UK before anywhere else on its global network.

Thomas Ramdahl, Chief Commercial Officer at Norwegian said: *"We're delighted to unlock another key gateway to the USA by launching the UK's cheapest nonstop flights to Chicago.*

"Our daily flights to Chicago builds upon our expanding long-haul network at London Gatwick and our strong reputation for providing high quality flights to iconic destinations at great value.

"Now leisure and business passengers can take advantage of convenient schedules and fly in comfort on our newest 787 Dreamliners to the Windy City."

Guy Stephenson, Chief Commercial Officer at Norwegian said: "It's fantastic to see Norwegian expanding its pioneering long-haul network from Gatwick with this new route to Chicago, which provides a crucial link between the UK and one of the world's most important business hubs. Chicago is also an American cultural epicentre and our passengers can look forward to enjoying its vibrant theatre scene, world-renowned architecture and iconic culinary offerings when they visit.

"Long-haul is thriving at Gatwick and this new service is a welcome addition to our diverse network of over 60 direct long-haul destinations."

The UK is not only one of our top international markets; it is also a vital part of our global strategic efforts to attract more visitors to the city. With this new route, more UK visitors will have the opportunity to visit Chicago for long weekend getaways as well as lengthier vacations."

Whitaker added: "Whether it's Chicago's breathtaking skyline, rich arts and culture offerings, world class dining scene or eclectic neighborhoods, we look forward to welcoming passengers aboard Norwegian's new flight to O'Hare International Airport to experience the vibrancy and excitement of one of America's greatest cities."

Members of Norwegian's loyalty programme, Norwegian Reward, can earn CashPoints when booking flights to Chicago. CashPoints are Norwegian Reward's currency that can be spent without restriction toward the cost of future flights with Norwegian, including extra baggage, seat reservation and flight taxes.

Norwegian currently serves 11 US destinations nonstop from London Gatwick including, Denver, Seattle and Austin, which launches on 27 March. Last month, the airline continued its global expansion by commencing its first

route to South America with a four-weekly service from London to Buenos Aires, Argentina.

The airline has been voted Skytrax '<u>World's Best Low Cost Long Haul Airline</u>' by travellers worldwide three years consecutively and has also been voted Skytrax 'Best Low Cost Airline Europe' six years in a row.
